



## June 4, 2017: God Is Faithful to His Covenant

**Adults:** (Singles, College, Newlyweds, Empty Nesters, etc.)

1. How does God's faithfulness to bring fruit out of our affliction encourage you to remain faithful during desperate and trying times?
2. Are you holding a grudge? Pen a prayer asking for forgiveness and the grace to forgive. Then plan your steps to seek reconciliation.
3. Since Jesus is the Savior who offers forgiveness to the world, how can we be part of the commission to take the message of forgiveness to all peoples?

**Students:** (Grades 6th-12th)

1. Why is it important not to hold grudges, especially in our family?
2. How can studying the Bible and praying together help us be patient with and forgive one another?
3. What are some challenges our family has faced that have drawn us closer together and closer to God?
4. What are some verses our family clings to when struggling to believe that God is in control?

**Children:** (K-5th Grade)

1. How did Joseph's dreams come true?
2. How did God use evil for good?
3. When someone wrongs you, do you choose to forgive or to seek revenge?

**Preschool:**

1. Joseph was young last time he saw his brothers. Encourage your preschooler to imagine life as a grown-up.
2. Joseph forgave his brothers for hurting him. Share about a time you forgave someone or someone forgave you.
