



**September 3, 2017: The Bronze Serpent**

**Adults:** (Singles, College, Newlyweds, Empty Nesters, etc.)

1. How should we respond to the disastrous consequences of sin that we find in ourselves? In our community? In our world?
2. How should our evangelistic efforts be impacted by the truth that everyone who believes in Jesus will be saved?
3. What are some opportunities in which you can plead with others to “be reconciled to God” through Jesus Christ?

**Students:** (Grades 6th-12th)

1. What are some instructions or answers our family is waiting to hear from God?
2. How can we remain patient as we continue to wait to hear from Him? Why is this important?
3. What are we supposed to do as we wait for God?
4. How can our patience in waiting for God be a testimony to others of our faith and trust in Him?

**Children:** (K-5th Grade)

1. How were the Israelites healed? (They looked at the bronze snake.)
2. Can people save themselves from sin? (No, only Jesus saves; John 14:6)
3. When someone in your family grumbles, stop and thank God for caring for you.

**Preschool:**

1. What are some things we tend to complain about? Ask God to help you be thankful.
2. How can we point someone to Jesus this week?
