Adults: (Singles, College, Newlyweds, Empty Nesters, etc.)

1. What are some ways we can renew our trust in God's strength for the mission when we fall into discouragement and despair?
2. How might you be "putting out a fleece" instead of trusting and obeying God's call to service?
3. How might "boasting in our weakness" open doors for sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ?

Students: (Grades 6th-12th)

1. On a scale of 1 (no trust at all) to 10 (complete trust), how well would you rate your trust in God's presence and power—especially when you are afraid?
2. When has an experience of going through a difficult time brought our family closer to God?
3. How does remembering God's presence in that time comfort you still today?
4. What are some specific situations you anticipate facing this week? How can we pray about those for you?

Children: (K-5th Grade)

1. How many men went to battle with Gideon? (See Judges 7:7.)
2. Who was really responsible for the Israelites' victory?
3. Read Ephesians 2:8-9. Who saves us from our sin?

Preschool:

1. How do you think the 300 men felt going into battle?
2. What makes you afraid? Why?
